CLUB RULES

COLOURS:

The colours of the Club shall be [Teal](#) Black and White.

DESIGN:

As determined by the Executive Committee. This may vary between teams.

Deleted: Senior and Junior

UNIFORM:

[Body suit](#)

[Or](#) Playing skirt [and](#) Playing top

Playing windcheater – white (optional)

Playing socks

[\(If not in the Bodysuit uniform\)](#) Playing sports briefs – black

Playing track pant – MAY be worn – MUST be black

Warm-up jacket (optional)

N.B. [Body Suits](#), Playing skirt, socks and warm-up jacket must be purchased through the Club to ensure continuity of colour and design, to comply with Association requirements and registration.

MEMBERSHIP:

FEES

Club and Association fees. An account shall be issued by the Treasurer and is payable by the date set by the Executive Committee.

Non payment of fees shall result in the player not being permitted to take the court for official matches until the fee is paid in full.

UNIFORM FEES

An account shall be issued by the Treasurer and is payable within thirty (30) days of issue.

N.B. Unfinancial members including any from previous years may be ineligible for current membership.

CLEARANCES:

A clearance may only be granted during the season when a shift of residence causes distance to become a major problem for a player and providing the player is not recognized as being unfinancial.

TRANSPORT:

Individual arrangements to be made.

TEAM MEMBERS:

Under Age : At the discretion of the Executive Committee and in consultation with the coach whilst abiding by the Junior Sports Policy.

Senior : At the discretion of the Executive Committee and in consultation with the coach and selection panel if applicable.

COACHES RESPONSIBILITIES:

Advise Team Members of:

1. Coach's name and contact telephone number.
2. Practice days and time/s.
3. Ensure each team member is issued with a copy of the programme.
Ensure players are coached according to the official rules.
4. Ensure correct uniform is worn at official matches.
5. Ensure Captain and Vice Captain are chosen by secret vote.
6. If necessary, consult with Executive Committee re members of weekly team and ensure replacements are available in case of illness etc.

CAPTAIN'S RESPONSIBILITIES:

Ensure the following is available on Saturday and at training if applicable.

1. Scorecard is collected and completed.
2. First-aid kit
3. First-aid items replenished
4. Full set of clean bibs (bibs to be washed when required)
5. Ball/s and ensure ball is pumped up as required.
6. Stop watch
7. Scorer (reliable) and must be over fourteen (14) years of age
8. Spare playing uniform (Blood Policy)
9. Water supply – as per team direction

10. ENSURE ALL EQUIPMENT IS RETURNED IN GOOD ORDER TO THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE AT THE END OF THE SEASON (BIBS MUST BE WASHED)

PLAYERS RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Abide by the Code of Conduct at all times.
2. Notify Coach if unable to attend training due to illness or other valid reason
3. Notify Coach by Friday evening at the latest if unable to attend match due to illness or other valid reason, so a replacement can be contacted.

Any player who fails to attend training on three (3) consecutive occasions without a valid reason may be excluded from playing in an official match until such time as that player resumes regular training.

DISCIPLINE OF PLAYERS:

Any coach shall report any behaviour difficulties to a member of the Executive Committee who shall endeavour to solve any problems. Should this action not be appropriate or ineffective the Executive Committee shall be notified immediately.
